We will fly round trip Madison to Aspen with a short ride to Snowmass Village where we will again stay at the Snowmass Mountain Chalet, a ski in/ski out facility. Full breakfast and lunch is included daily. Snowmass Mountain Chalet is walking distance to Snowmass Village Mall for shopping and dining or just a short bus ride to Aspen with its many shops, galleries and dining. Snowmass has 91 trails serviced by 21 lifts, with many wide, groomed runs perfect for those first days of the new season. Your lift pass also allows for skiing at Aspen, Aspen Highlands and Buttermilk Mountains all just a short bus ride Aspen/Snowmass Nordic System also offers 40 miles of no fee groomed trails for individual or guided cross-country skiing or snowshoeing.

BIKING WITH THE SKI CLUB

On Sunday, September 30, 9 members of our Ski Club met at the Pacific Cycle parking lot on Hammersley Road for our annual bike ride. Carol and I led it again (we think our 13th year), this year riding on our tandem. This was a journey and not a race so no one was left behind or lost.

It was 28 miles of sheer pleasure (including climbing several hills along the way). Our weather was text-book perfect with temperatures in the mid to upper 60s, light winds, not a cloud in the bright blue sky and with fall colors at or near their peak.

The first 5 miles was a slight downhill grade on the SW Commuter Trail into Madison followed by miles of level biking, a tour past Monona Terrace and a picnic lunch at Fraboni's in Monona.

Cost of this trip is \$1,588 per person, based on double occupancy (\$400 single supplement). (Price is subject to airline fuel surcharge). Please call Larry Hurley to check availability- 271-2378.

Trip Includes round trip airfare, transfer to and from Mountain Chalet, 6 nights lodging at Snowmass Mountain Chalet, hot breakfast and lunch daily, club parties, baggage handling, room attendant gratuities, and all room and air taxes.

Not included are dinners, lift tickets, and personal expenses. Special group lift ticket prices will be announced later.

By flying in/out of Santa Fe, we can eliminate a bus ride from Albuquerque and can add a day to the trip, returning late Tuesday, February 5. This allows us to add a 4th day of skiing followed by a 5th day of touristic pursuits in Santa Fe before returning home. What's more? We're able to offer this 6-day trip for \$1289 per person, based on double occupancy (\$325 single supplement). That's \$100 less than the price we were earlier able to offer for 3 ski days at Taos and 1 day of Santa Fe sightseeing! If you've been thinking about a ski trip this year, this is the one for you! 5500 skiable acres, 220 named runs, an average of 400 inches of dry powder snow, and virtually no lift lines. . . this is **Big Sky, Montana**.

Big Sky is known for its long, wide open groomers over 3 interconnected mountains. A new lift provides access to Moonlight Basin (previously accessible only by snowcat). Terrain is 15% beginner, 25% intermediate, 40% advanced, 20% expert.

We'll be staying at the historic **Huntley Lodge** in the heart of Big Sky's mountain village. In addition to ski in/ski out access, the lodge is part of a larger complex offering numerous amenities, including a full service health spa. We had the occasion to tour there recently and feel Huntley Lodge will be great for our group. We'll be enjoying comfortable, nicely appointed guest rooms; several inviting sitting areas, each with a huge fireplace; and, what we are told is, an outstanding full breakfast buffet. In addition to the bar and restaurant at the lodge, many other dining options and shops are located within easy walking distance in the village, as well as via shuttle in the town of Big Sky.

We'll depart Madison bright and early Sunday morning, **March 10, 2013** by chartered bus to Chicago, O'Hare, where we'll catch our <u>direct flight</u> to Bozeman. From there, a bus transfer through scenic countryside brings us into Big Sky by midafternoon. We reverse the itinerary for our return on Saturday, **March 16, 2013**, leaving Big Sky late morning to get back to Madison in the evening.

Trip Includes: round trip airfare and bus transfers, 6 nights lodging, 6 breakfasts, club parties, baggage handling, room attendant gratuities, and all room and air taxes. Not included: meals other than breakfast, lift tickets, personal expenses. Special group lift ticket pricing will be announced later.

Trip Price: \$1,690 per person for those "early birds" who submit their reservation and deposit by **November 15, 2012**. Thereafter, price is \$1,790. **Final deadline for sign-up is December 15, 2012**. Trip price is based on double occupancy (single supplement is available for \$555).

A \$300 per person deposit is required with your reservation. A second payment of \$1,200 is due January 15, 2013; and final payment of remaining balance is due on February 15, 2013.
